Eligibility:

Ladies and Men who are members of a German golf club associated with the German Golf Association with an EGA Handicap not exceeding -53.

Ladies and Men who are a member of a foreign golf club associated with its respective national golf union/federation/association with an EGA Handicap not exceeding -53 and with a valid EDGA Pass. National Associations must certify their players' EGA Handicaps within 14 days prior to the closing date for entries.

Limit of exact handicap and entries:

Ladies and Men -53,0

In case of more than 90 entries for ladies and men, competitors with the highest handicap will be excluded. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed immediately after the closing date. They will be placed on a waiting list with the opportunity to compete in case of subsequent withdrawals.

If, for any reason, a competitor is unable to participate, this must be communicated to the German Golf Association by 20th August 2019.

Category 1: Players with an EGA Handicap of 4.4 or lower
Category 2: Players with an EGA Handicap between 4.5 and 11.4
Category 3: Players with an EGA Handicap between 11.5 and 18.4
Category 4: Players with an EGA Handicap between 18.5 and 26.4
Category 5: Players with an EGA Handicap between 26.5 and 36
Category 6: Players with an EGA Handicap between 36 and 53

Categories can be unified by the Committee in case of a low number of players.

A sudden death play-off will be used to determine the winner if there is a tie for first place. If a playoff involves more than two players, those other than the winner will be deemed to have tied for second place regardless of their scores in the play-off. Ties other than for first place will not be subject to play-offs.

Prizes:

The winning Lady will be honoured as "German International Ladies Disabled Champion 2019". Gold, silver and bronze medals of the German Golf Association (only category 1 – 3).

The winning Man will be honoured as "German International Men´s Disabled Champion 2019". Gold, silver and bronze medals of the German Golf Association (only category 1 – 3).

Additional prizes in the categories 1 – 4 if there is a minimum of 3 players each category.

Only players with an German citizen will be included in the German Championship.

Tees:

The tees to be played will be announced before the practice round.
