



CADNO Schedule of Events 2020 Canadian Amputee and Disabled National Open 2020 at Bridges Golf Course Starbuck, Manitoba August 4 to 7, 2020

The 2020 Canadian Amputee and Disabled National Open (CADNO) will be held in Starbuck, Manitoba at Bridges Golf Course. This event is the 30th edition of our tournament and will be a 54 hole tournament open to all amputees and people with qualifying disabilities.

Bridges Golf Course is an 18-hole golf course settled on the banks of the La Salle river. The course presents a unique layout that combines both a traditional links style, with a challenging tree lined golfing experience. The golf course in Starbuck is located 25 minutes from our host hotel, the Four Points by Sheraton Winnipeg South. We will have daily transportation to and from the golf course and hotel. For those interested in using the daily transportation to and from the golf course, I would appreciate knowing well in advance so that we can plan accordingly.

Winnipeg is the capital city of Manitoba and is home to many attractions including The Canadian Museum for Human Rights, the polar bears at the Winnipeg Zoo and the Forks which is a meeting place where the Red River and Assiniboine Rivers meet. Winnipeg is home to professional football and baseball teams during the summer. We will be attending a Winnipeg Goldeyes baseball game one evening. The Winnipeg International Airport (YWG) is also a 25 minute drive to the hotel.

As mentioned, the host hotel is the Four Points by Sheraton Winnipeg South located at 2935 Pembina Highway, Winnipeg, Manitoba, R3T 2H5. A block of rooms has been reserved at a rate of \$125 + tax <u>until July 3rd</u>. Book your room early to ensure availability. The 54-hole tournament will have different yardage options to play from but any golfer wishing to compete for the championship will compete from the white tees at 6400 yards. Ladies and any senior division can play from the 5500 yard distance.

Please let me know if you're planning on playing a practise round on the Tuesday so I may have enough tee times blocked off for the event.
